Note:

2. If an HS code has no trades during either the current period or the previous period, then value and market share for the period without any trade are set to zero. Please note that year-over-year changes are calculated as the difference between values during the current period and the corresponding values during the same one year ago.

$$\text{Year-Over-Year Changes} = (\text{Amount during Current Period}) - (\text{Amount during Same Period one year before})$$

3. Definitions:

$$\text{Market Share in Value (\%)} = 100 * (\text{Value for a country}) / (\text{Total Value for US-All Countries})$$

4. Import Value is based on District of Entry data, not District of Unloading.
